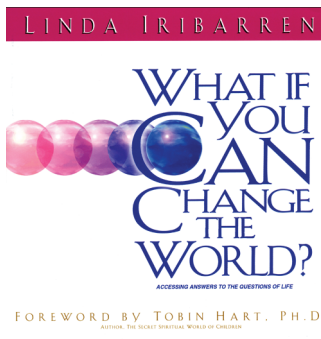

A product of the imagination of leadership consultant Linda Iribarren, each left-hand page of *What if You Can Change the World?* contains a quote that relates to the “what if” question on the right-hand page facing it. For example, the Emily Dickinson quote, “The Possible’s slow fuse is lit by the Imagination,” faces the question, “What if imagination presents options?” Other quotes come from Eckhart Tolle, Caroline Myss, Emanuel Swedenborg, Deepak Chopra, Ovid, Marianne Williamson, and many others.

The book can be read from cover to cover, which is what I did first. I then enjoyed just opening the book to a page when the mood struck or I had an issue I was working with. As expected, the page I chose posed a meaningful question for me. Iribarren’s book is excellent for customers who look at their lives from a spiritual viewpoint. The quotes and questions emphasize the idea of people accepting responsibility for their actions and choices. Reading *What if You Can Change the World?* becomes a form of self-therapy.

The simplicity and directness of presentation enhance the book’s ability to empower readers. The right question at the right time can have life-altering effects. An extensive appendix with a bibliography and resources on topics such as children, relationships, and business will guide people seeking further reading.
